

St. Paul Traffic Changes for Monday, Jan. 16th, 2017

- North entrance to the property (alongside the church) will now be **CLOSED**.
- South entrance to the property (alongside the priest residence), and the subsequent drop-off/pick up area by the covered area will be **operating as usual**.
The “no left turn” rule on St. Albans is unfortunately not always respected, so please know that it will be strictly enforced!
We ask that families with Kindergarten students and students who require assistance use this lot, and ALL OTHER FAMILIES USE THE *NEW BACK LOT OPTION*.

NEW Option for drop-off pick up: BACK PARKING LOT.

- There will be **NO PARKING** available in this lot – it will be a continuous line of moving cars that will allow for **drop off/pick up only**.
- Children **MUST** be able to exit and enter the car **on their own**. Parents/drivers are asked **to not leave the driver’s seat** at any time.
- The only access to this lot is from **Lundy Rd**, which runs along the back of the school. Lundy Rd. can be accessed from St. Albans via **Lucerne Rd**. Please see the following link for a map of the neighbourhood: (you will need to zoom in to see the surrounding streets.)

As you can see, there is another access route to Lundy, however to keep traffic flowing, we ask that all approaching traffic come south on Lundy from Lucerne. This will make the entry point to the back lot far less congested.

- Once you arrive to the back lot, the route will be clearly laid out with traffic cones, and our smiling school staff will be there to greet you and show you the way. We will also be out at the end of the day making sure your child gets into your car when you arrive. 😊
- Since we will now be using quiet, residential streets, we ask that you keep our neighbours happy by driving slowly at all times and respecting their property.
