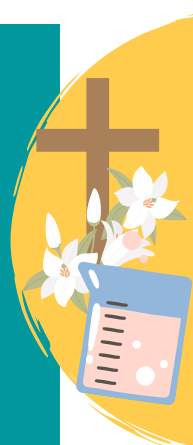

### When do I register?

Early bird registration starts on **Monday, March 27th**. Registration **closes** on **Friday, May 26th**.

### Where do I register?

Be sure to include the name of the camp you wish to register your child for, and your child's full name. Then mail/drop off a cheque made payable to **ST. PAUL PARISH** within 7 days of emailing your reservation to secure your spot. You will receive an email reply confirming your reservation. **Your reservation will be released within 7 days if payment is not received.** Please drop off/mail payment to **St. Paul Parish, attention Gail Imoo**. 8251 St. Albans Rd., Richmond, BC V6Y 2L2.

### What will my child need?

Please send nut-free snacks, water bottle, hat, sunscreen, and closed-toe play shoes. Children should wear comfortable play clothes that may get dirty.

### Refunds

If you withdraw your child from camp by:

- May 19th, you will receive a full refund
- June 2nd, you will receive 75% of payment
- June 9th, you will receive 50% of payment
- June 12th, you are not eligible for a refund

(Medical reasons, with a doctor's note, will be considered.)

### Camp Cancellations

Should we need to cancel camps, we will do our best to communicate this as soon as a decision is reached. However, we reserve the right to cancel a camp up to 7 days prior to the camp start date. In such situations, a full refund will be processed accordingly.
